BACKFLOW CERTIFICATE

Inspections are required in accordance with Ordinance Number 959 and the Code of the City of Louisburg. Testing intervals shall not exceed one (1) year and backflow preventers shall be overhauled as required to keep the device in proper working order. Backflow preventers are required on commercial buildings and lawn (sprinklers) where backflow may occur and where there is a hazard of contamination of potable water supply.

ORDINANCE NO. 959

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF LOUISBURG, KANSAS, CHAPTER XV. UTILITIES, ARTICLE 2. WATER BY DELETING SECTION 15-212D, SUBSECTION MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR AND CREATING A NEW SECTION 15-212D, SUBSECTION MAINTNANCE AND REPAIR AND REPEALING ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LOUISBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code of the City of Louisburg, Kansas, Chapter XV. Utilities, Article 2. Water be amended by deleting Section 15-212D, Subsection **Maintenance and Repair** and creating a new Section 15-212D, Subsection **Maintenance and Repair** as follows:

Maintenance and Repair.

It shall be the responsibility of building and premise owners to maintain all backflow preventers and vacuum breakers within the building or on the premises in good working order and to make sure no piping or other arrangements have been installed for the purpose of bypassing the backflow devices. Testing and repair of these devices should be made by qualified technicians (qualified technicians are those technicians who have completed a Kansas Department of Health and Environment approved training course and have passed a written examination). The public works director shall certify the device testers after ascertaining the technician meets the above qualifications. The public works director will also assure the proper installation of all backflow preventers and will set appropriate testing and overhaul schedules for such devices. Testing intervals shall not exceed one (1) year and overhaul shall be as needed.

(a) Certified Tester/Repair Technicians. All certified tester/repair technicians shall be re-certified at no less than three year intervals. Persons certified as tester/repair technicians at the time of adoption of this ordinance shall continue to be certified for a period of not more than three (3) years as determined by the public works director.


SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
