STO Section 204: Fines Doubled in Road Construction and School Zones

- (a) Fines listed in the schedule of fines, as established by the Municipal Court Judge, shall be doubled if a person is convicted of an ordinance infraction, which is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed within any road construction zone.
- (b) Fines listed in the schedule of fines, as established by the Municipal Court Judge relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school zone authorized under subsection (a)(4) of K.S.A. 8-1560, and amendments there to. (K.S.A. Supp. 8-2218)
